

CAMERA MOVEMENTS

DOLLYING/TRUCKING

- The camera is mounted on wheels which moves for a very smooth movement. Also known as a *tracking shot* or *trucking shot*.



PAN SHOT

- A *pan* is a horizontal camera movement in which the camera moves left and right about a central axis. This is a swiveling movement, i.e. mounted in a fixed location on a [tripod](#) or shoulder, rather than a [dolly](#)-like movement in which the entire mounting system moves.



TILT SHOT

- Vertical movement of the camera angle, i.e. pointing the camera up and down (as opposed to moving the whole camera up and down).
