CAMERA MOVEMENTS


DOLLYING/TRUCKING

• The camera is mounted on wheels which moves for a very smooth movement. Also known as a *tracking shot* or *trucking shot*.



PAN SHOT

 A pan is a horizontal camera movement in which the camera moves left and right about a central axis. This is a swiveling movement, i.e. mounted in a fixed location on a tripod or shoulder, rather than a dolly-like movement in which the entire mounting system moves.



TILT SHOT

 Vertical movement of the camera angle, i.e. pointing the camera up and down (as opposed to moving the whole camera up and down).
